SUMMARY

- Main Campus enrollment stands at 16,238, this number includes those students who are enrolled exclusively on-line
- The 3,124 African American students enrolled represent 19.2% and the total minority enrollment is 3,578 or 22.0%. Both based on total main campus enrollment
- Enrollment of First-Time Freshmen increased by 370 students, from 1,911 Fall 2006 to 2,281 Fall 2007
- Average ACT score for First-Time Freshmen is 23.6
