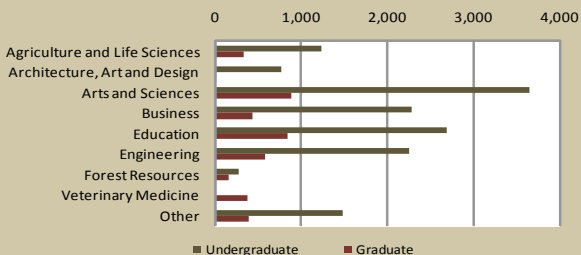



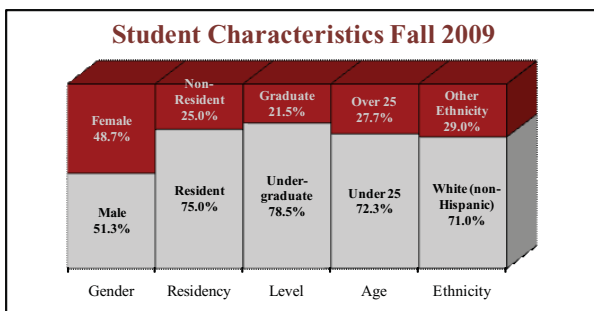
Adjacent States Enrollment Fall 2009

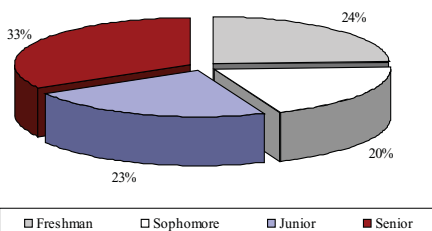

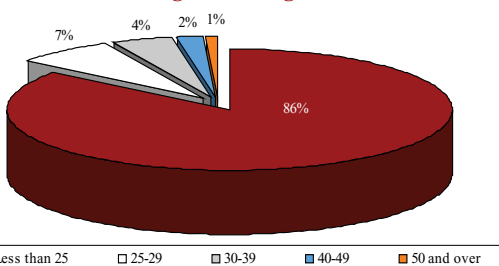
Fall 2009 Undergraduate Class Distribution

Fall 2009 Undergraduate Age Distribution

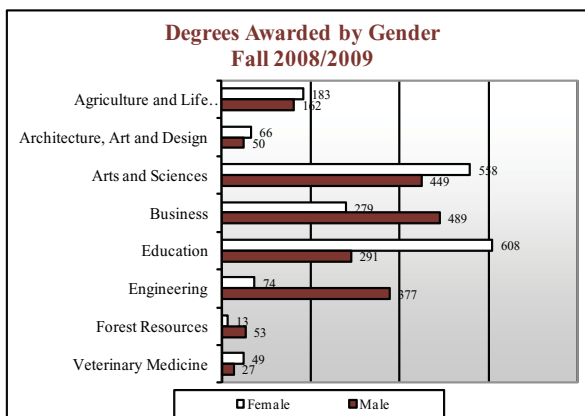

Degrees Awarded by Gender Fall 2008/2009



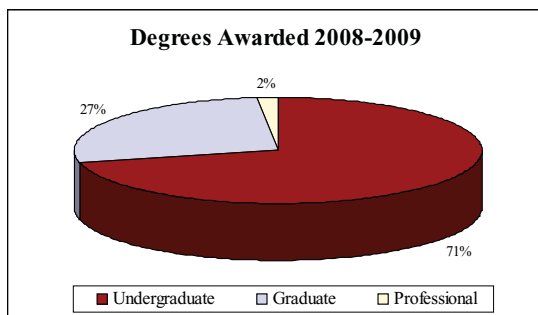

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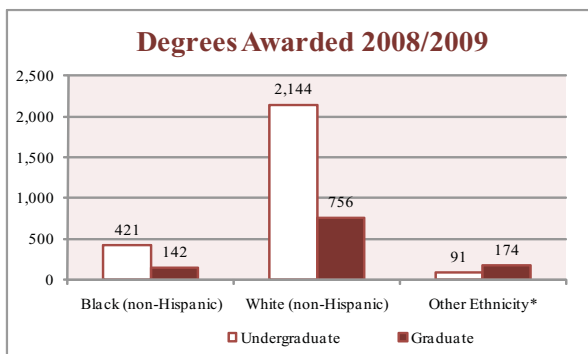

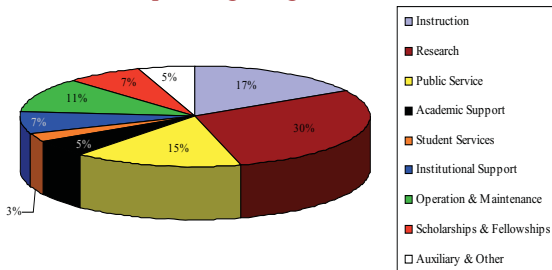
